Queen Street itself is as old as Toronto, and by the late 1800s, was the principal east/west artery of the city. Its original residential character was eventually overtaken by a commercial role, and today, Queen Street from University Avenue to Lansdowne is a continual, connected collage of Victorian commercial architecture.

West Queen West Art & Design District – Designated 2004

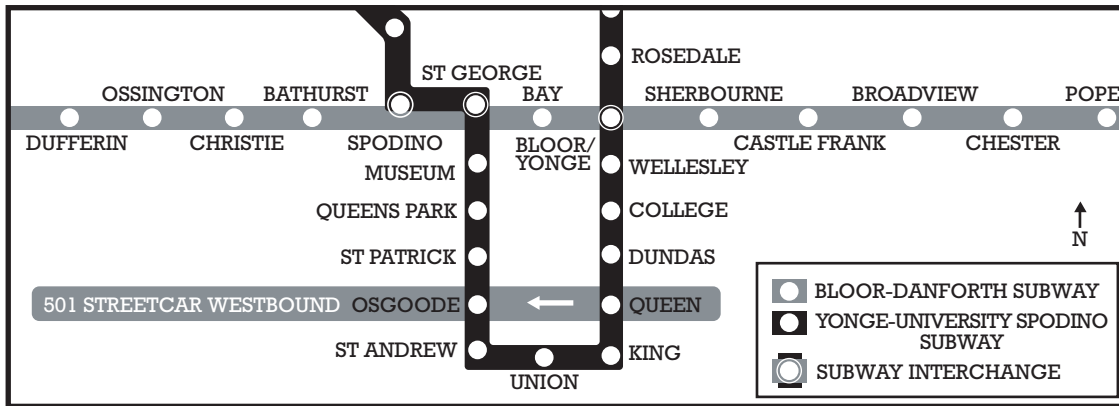

Step off the subway at Queen or Osgoode station and take the 501 westbound Queen streetcar to Bathurst and walk two blocks west, or continue on the streetcar to Manning, which intersects at Australian Boot Company. Look for the big orange store with boots hammered to the façade. We are sandwiched in between Quasi Mode and Studio Deluxe on the south side of queen Street, alongside other local landmarks Songbird Music and Dufflet Pastries..

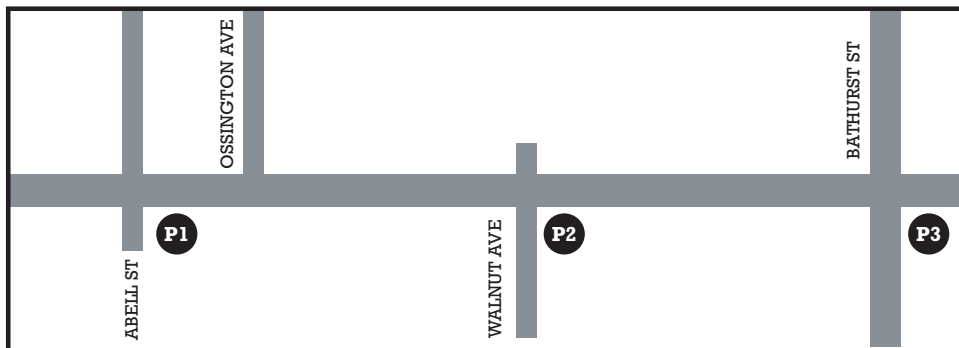
